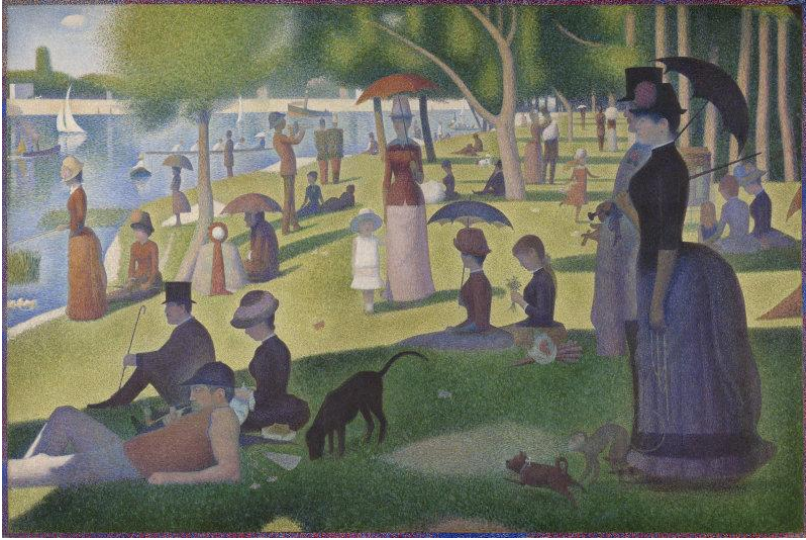


Georges Seurat
